



Lulu goes to hospital

The nurse put magic white cream on my back and then a plaster. It felt cold.




The doctor and nurse said I would have to give my legs a big hug and stay really still in a ball and sing my favorite song.

The nurse said I might feel a little ouch on my back and not to be afraid, just keep singing my song.




The doctor rubbed off my magic cream. I felt a little ouch, but I kept on singing. The nurse even sang with me!
