NEW ICU EXTENSION

2020 - 2022

The ICU expansion will incorporate a balance of innovative and advanced technologies enabling efficient and improved quality of care for patients. This expansion will reflect TUH status as a model four Hospital and a regional referral centre.

NEW RENAL UNIT

The Vartry Renal Unit opened in October 2020 on time and on budget. The Vartry Renal unit provides a patient centred environment with larger capacity. There is a Home Therapies Unit and a self-care Haemodialysis Unit. The 2,700m2 Unit built over two floors has 28 Haemodialysis Treatment Bays, six single haemodialysis rooms for immunocompromised / acutely ill patients, four home dialysis training (Peritoneal & Haemodialysis) rooms and for the first time in Ireland, four self-care haemodialysis bays. There are also 14 offices which for the first time brings all the different medical and allied health care professionals that are involved in the care of renal patients together.





EXPANDING ADULT MEDICAL OUTPATIENTS

In keeping with the Hospital strategy of a 'Hospital without walls' over 20,000 Outpatient
Appointments now take place in Hospital clinics in the Tallaght Community across a multitude of specialties including: Cardiology, Endocrinology, Vascular, Neurology and Radiology.

NEW PAEDIATRIC OUTPATIENT AND URGENT CARE CENTRE

The CHI @ TUH is Paediatric Outpatient and Urgent Care Centre is part of a clinical network of care with the new children's hospital in line with the National model of Care for Paediatric Healthcare Services in Ireland.





OUR NEW CRÈCHE

NEW INPATIENT CARE WING Vision For The Future

Growing TUH to meet the changing demographics of our population, with proposed building of additional bed capacity for acute and elective care. This building will reflect contemporary models of care delivery which will be driven by technology and research; including a clinical research facility in association with Trinity College Dublin.





LABORATORY EXPANSION

Configured laboratory Services under a framework of advanced state-of-the-art technology linked by track automation and robotics coupled with appropriate skill mix and consolidation of discipline specific services.





TUH COMMUNITY RADIOLOGY SERVICES

Tallaght Cross provides plain film x-ray and ultrasound scanning to community referred GP patients in a comfortable setting adjacent to the campus under the governance of TUH.





REEVES DAY SURGERY CENTRE

Opened October 2020 the 3,460 Sq M facility with four theatres and 25 recovery beds is located across the road from the main hospital. It will eliminate long wait times for routine day surgery and increase elective day surgery activity. The goal of the new facility is to reduce day surgery waiting times to a maximum of three months when fully operational.
